

The Ten Commandments to control virus.



1. When cross-fostering moves only the surplus piglets and minimizes moving of piglets.
2. No cross-fostering longer than 48 hours.
3. Avoid spread of diseases when handling the piglets. Keep the piglets in the pen.
4. Don't move disease piglets. Kill them.
5. Wean all piglets from a week batch at the same time.
6. Weaned piglets in the farrowing house are banned.
7. Strict batch. All in- all out.

8. No contact between different age groups.
9. No contact between piglets from weaning up to 6 months of age and sows.
10. Always introduce incoming gilts via quarantine also home produce gilts.
